VE Day

Many thanks to those that organised and participated in the VE day celebrations. It's been lovely hearing how enjoyable the day was. Our thanks to NWBC for their £250 grant to the Parish Council to purchase the bunting for the Village Green which looked spectacular. It also funded the purchase of a nice range of giant garden games which went on the Green and will be available for use at future events.



Fly tipping

The Parish Council were very disappointed to discover a resident fly tipping wood waste onto King George V Playing fields. Despite contacting the resident and giving them an opportunity to remove, the resident chose to leave the waste. The Parish Council then had to arrange and pay for the waste to be removed. Fly tipping on private land is illegal and the Parish Council take this seriously. The resident has now been invoiced for the cost of removal and the matter reported to Warwickshire Police and NWBC.

Playing Fields Signage

Location signage boards are now in production for the playing fields. We will also put on our website and noticeboard, to make it easier for people not familiar with the village.

Dog waste bins

Grand Union Canal Transfer Project

During last month (April) the Parish Council dealt with a request from the Planning Inspectorate in Bristol that has not only informed us that this project is now defined as one that meets the criteria for becoming a Nationally Significant Infrastructure Project (NSIP) but also a request for us to comment by the end of the month, upon the content of the Environmental Impact Assessments received thus far.

We have noted the former which allows the Planning Inspectorate to deny or grant development consent, and because of the severe time constraint placed upon us, we have written to the Planning Inspectorate with a host of concerns about the content of these assessments , that, inter alia demean the

- **Impact upon our very local land characteristic**
- **Also, the visual aspect we similarly enjoy, and**
- **The very local biodiversity we also enjoy**

And by expressing great concern about the potential for

- **An increase in lighting and noise pollution**
- **An increase with the emissions of pollutants such as odours**
- **A decrease in overall air quality expectations**

This list is not exhaustive.

Looking ahead, and before a full application is submitted (expected fourth quarter 2026) there will be another public consultation to be held with us on a date and time to be agreed.

We will, of course update everyone just as soon as there is more information to impart.
